Welcome to the Mustique Conservation Area

Mustique is a privately owned island with a responsibility for 'Conservation' enshrined in the Mustique Company Limited Act 2002 passed by the government of St. Vincent and the Grenadines. This act declared the island, together with the beaches and surrounding waters a Conservation Area.

In order to ensure compliance with the Act, respect for the privacy of residents, and a safe and pleasant visit, the Management of The Mustique Company has supplied the following guidelines:

- If Mustique is your "first Port of call" to St. Vincent & the Grenadines, you MUST declare your entry with Customs & Immigration Department. Please call: 1 784 488 8410 for further instructions.
- Use only designated areas at Britannia Bay for mooring & anchoring. Areas which are sand only contain a wealth of delicate marine organisms vital to the eco-system and must be protected.
- Please use the chart below for fees payable, which entitles you to three (3) consecutive nights stay.

Mooring Fees

LENGTH OF VESSEL	\$EC	\$US
Up to – 70ft	\$200.00	\$75.00
71ft – 100ft	\$450.00	\$170.00
101ft – 150ft	\$550.00	\$210.00
151ft – and over	\$1000.00	\$385.00

In the case for day trips and tours, a head tax for non-Vincentian citizens is applied at EC\$40.00 per person. A daily mooring/anchorage rate is available @ \$300. Fees are payable at the Moorings office opposite the Jetty.

We ask you to observe the following:

- Island bus tours are available on designated routes. These routes will vary from time to time during the busy season in order to protect areas throughout the island and to ensure the privacy of residents and guests, (passengers will not be permitted to be dropped off at beaches or other locations).
- On occasions, buses will not be permitted to tour the island.
- Visitors are asked to use the designated areas shown on the map at the back of this booklet.
- Holding tanks are not to be emptied into the Island waters.
- Garbage bins are provided at the jetty.
- Use of jet skis, water skis & spear guns are prohibited.

- Fishing is not allowed.
- DRONES are not permitted.
- Animals are not allowed on the island, unless cleared by the Government Animal Health Dept.
- Nudity is not allowed; swimwear should be reserved for beach areas only.
- BBQ & Picnic areas are reserved for Homeowners & Guests only. Portable BBQ's are not allowed.
- Photography of private homes or guests is not allowed, please respect the privacy of persons on Mustique. From time to time cameras will be prohibited.
- If you wish to snorkel, please do not stand on the reef or remove anything from the water.
- Flora & Fauna must not be removed or disturbed.

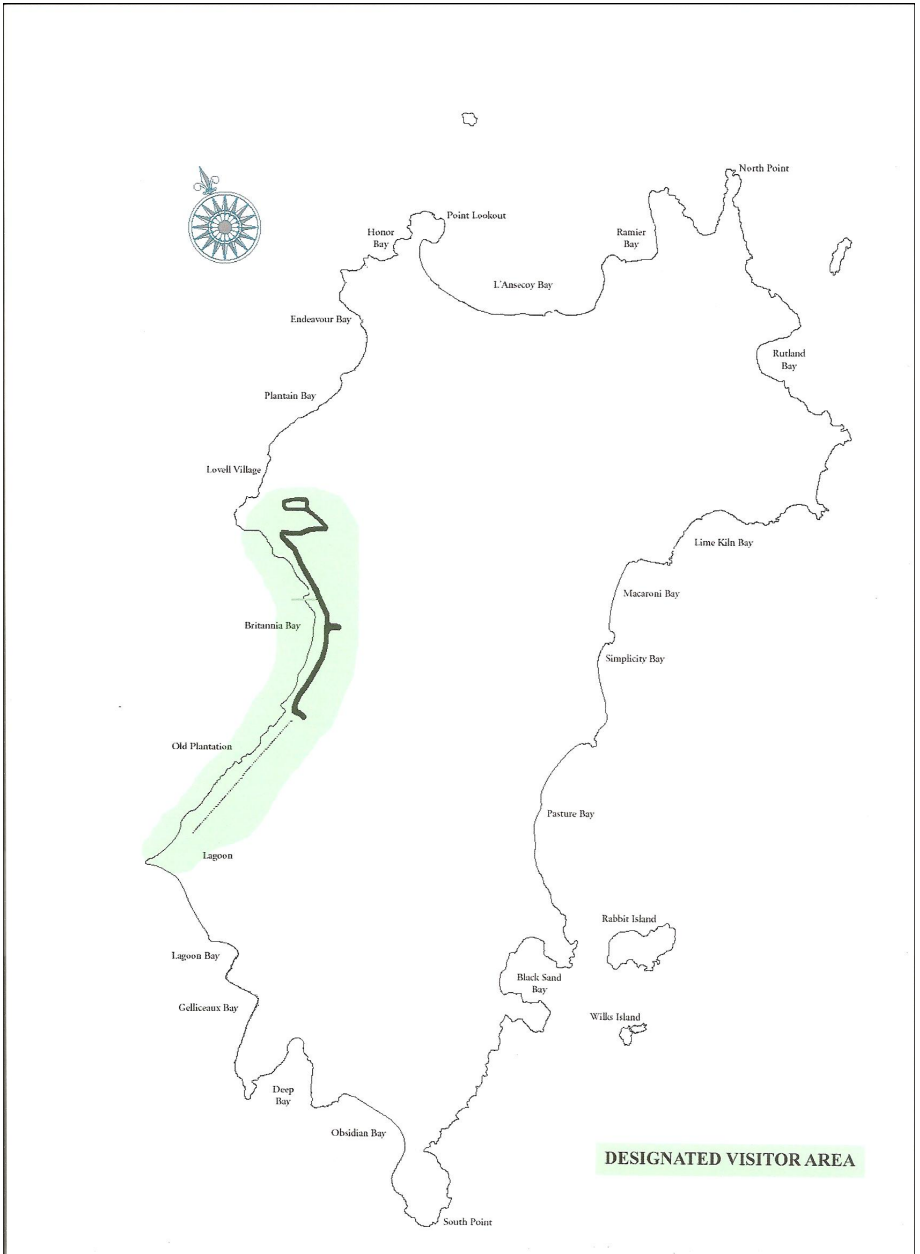
